**Deuteronomy 14:1-29**

*Deuteronomy stresses God's faithfulness as our covenant-keeping King and urges His people to obey Him with all our minds, hearts, and souls as we await the prophet greater than Moses.*

  - 21:1-25:19 Honoring God's presence in the land (24:4b)
